- 3) Newick Village Hall the grass area to the front of the hall and the bank next to the car park behind the hall
- 4) King George V Playing Field see darker green area on map 3
- 5) East Sussex County Council Highway Verges within village see shaded areas on maps 4 and 5

Contractor to provide:-

- 1. Summary of company structure and how long it has been trading
- 2. Evidence of financial stability (copy accounts etc.)
- 3. Trade qualifications held (all operatives involved in mowing highway verges must be NRSWA qualified).
- 4. Details of public liability insurance (£10million) and Employer's Liability Insurance
- 5. Health & Safety Policy
- 6. Risk Assessments
- 7. Experience of similar work
- 8. Contact details of clients who can be approached for references

Three year contract commencing 1st April 2026 with annual reviews
